From the interior designed bedrooms (book one with your own outdoor hot tub if you can) to the fairytale swimming pool, it manages to be both uber cool and invitingly intimate. Imagine staying at your friends' luxury holiday villa, if your friends were the Beckhams, and you've got it.

Spa seclusion

Hotel spas can be underwhelming but this is a real wow experience, even for those who don't normally like to put in the dressing gown hours. Book the private spa cave for two and relax in the stunning



lagoon-like Jacuzzi, then make the time for a massage. Mine was one of the best massages I've had in 15 years of being a beauty editor.

Out, out

Mykonos is famous for its nightlife and there's something for everyone. People watch the glam crowd at gourmet restaurant Remezzo, then for world-class cocktails and the perfect place to watch the sun set, head to Bao's cocktail bar in Little

Venice. Want to end the night with a party? Try Jackie O's, situated on the waterfront – it's a lively, buzzy club with fun nightly drag shows.

If you leave Kensho without having at least one dinner in the hotel restaurant, then you're missing out. Chef George Stylianoudakis is ex-Le Manoir aux Quat'Saisons, AKA the Oxfordshire double Michelin starred restaurant you have to book months in advance for, and it shows. Expect delicious interpretations of Greek classics, which arrive looking like works of art. For the ultimate treat, splash out on the ten course tasting menu (maybe one for the gift list...)
